Located at site of our estate vineyard and winery, the Wood Estate Vineyard is a heritage vine site planted at the turn of the century to Zinfandel and Alicante Bouschet. While the exact number of Alicante Buschet vines is unknown, we estimate a total of 5% inter-plantings among the 9-acre lot. A combination of sedimentary striations embedded among clay soils set within a cool growing environment pierced by perpetual and even sunlight produces bold and powerful results.

: Winemaker's Insight :

This is our second vintage from this historic location and it is proving to be a powerhouse Zinfandel. Lively aromatics of boysenberry, blueberry, black cherry, and lavender catch curiosity immediately. The wine's hue sheets the glass with jet black ink, indicative of Alicante Buuschet's influence on the concentration of color. The mouthfeel is a viscous, luscious harmony of star anise, black plum, blackberries, and savory sweet bliss. Anticipated maturity window: 2020 to 2026.
